


Treating an Open Fracture

- ◆ Do not draw exposed bones back into tissue.
- ◆ Do not irrigate wound.


DO:

- ◆ Cover wound.
- ◆ Splint fracture without disturbing wound.
- ◆ Place a moist 4" x 4" dressing over bone end to prevent drying.



Closed Fracture

Closed Fracture in which the fracture does not puncture the skin.



Open Fracture

Open Fracture in which the bone protrudes through the skin.

Treating Amputations

- ◆ Control bleeding
- ◆ Treat for shock
- ◆ Save tissue parts, wrapped in clean cloth
- ◆ Keep tissue cool
- ◆ Keep tissue with the victim

Treating Impaled Objects

- ◆ Immobilize.
- ◆ Don't move or remove.
- ◆ Control bleeding.
- ◆ Clean and dress wound.
- ◆ Wrap.
